The Garden Ridge City Quarry Commission will meet in regular session on Monday, September 12th, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 9400 Municipal Parkway, Garden Ridge, Texas. This is an open meeting, open to the public, subject to the Open Meetings Law of the State of Texas, and as required by law, notice is hereby posted on or before September 9th, 2011 before 5:00 p.m., providing time, place, date and agenda thereof. The meeting facility is wheelchair accessible and accessible parking spaces are provided. Requests for accommodations or interpretative services must be made 48 hours prior to this meeting.

Rules for Citizen's Participation:

The Quarry Commission welcomes citizen participation and comments at all of their Commission Meetings. As a courtesy to your fellow citizens and out of respect to our appointed officials, we must request that if you wish to speak, that you follow these guidelines.

- a. Direct your comments to the entire Commission, not to an individual member, nor to the audience.
- b. Show the Quarry Commission the same respect and courtesy that you expect to be shown to you.
- c. Limit remarks to three (3) minutes.

*NOTE: The Texas Open Meetings Act permits a member of the public or a member of the governmental body to raise a subject that has not been included in the notice for the meeting. However, any discussion of the subject **must be limited** to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting and any response to a question posed to the Quarry Commission is limited to either a statement of specific factual information or a recitation of existing policy. TEX. GOV'T CODE § 551.042.*

5. Discussion and Recommendations to City Council:

- a. Advise City Council of tentative date for public meeting on the Quarry (Feb 2012).

6. New Business / Discuss and Consider Action On:

- a. Review previous month's blast.

Review and discussion of the monthly Hanson Quarry blasting analysis data reported by Joe Crownover of Vibratex. Discussion with Ken Early of Hanson Servtex and Blasting contractors, on recent quarry operations, including any unusual blasts that occurred last month.

- b. Citizen blast report follow-up.
- c. Report by Bruce Northup, Austin Powder on scaled distance and other blasting issues.
- d. Follow up, as necessary, on reports: Mental health issues as they might relate to quarry operations (Mudge); Commission accomplishments (Warden, Gunnarson); Damage report form and follow up procedure (Mudge); What the commission can better do to support and communicate with the citizens of Garden Ridge (Holloway). What is next?
- e. Discuss public meeting (report from Public Meeting Committee).
- f. Discuss ORD 34 as amended (report from Ord. 34 Committee), distance recommendation and other environmental issues. Be prepared to forward recommendations no later than Oct 2011 if at all possible.
- g. Discuss Grapevine article and monitor locations.
- h. Discuss appointment of Quarry Commission Chairman.

7. Review individual citizen complaints and assign Quarry Commission member contact, as necessary.


Agenda Notices:

AT ANY TIME DURING ANY MATTER LISTED ON THIS AGENDA, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIR, THE COMMISSION MAY RECESS THE REGULAR SESSION AND RECONVENE INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION SHOULD IT BE NECESSARY TO SEEK THE ADVICE OF ITS ATTORNEYS REGARDING ANY MATTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 551 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE.

This Agenda has been reviewed and approved by the organization's legal counsel and the presence of any subject in any Executive Session portion of the agenda constitutes a written interpretation of Texas Government Code Chapter 551 by legal counsel for the governmental body and constitutes an opinion by the attorney that the items discussed therein may be legally discussed in the closed portion of the meeting considering available opinions of a court of record and opinions of the Texas Attorney General known to the attorney.
