


**FIRST AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER
FOR THE CITY OF GARDEN RIDGE, TEXAS**

In addition to continuing all Precautionary Public Health Measures implemented on March 13 and 17, 2020 and by the authority of the City Council, the Mayor of the City of Garden Ridge, declares the following additional Precautionary Public Health Measures be implemented effective at 11:59 p.m. on April 9, 2020:


1. Due to the risk of the rapid spread of the COVID-19 virus, and the need to protect the members of the community, the following additional Public Health Measures shall be implemented and remain in effect until thirty (30) days after the local emergency order expires or is expressly revoked. The following provisions of the City's Zoning Ordinance 13-122018, are temporarily amended and/or suspended as follows:
 - a) RV's, travel trailers, campers, and motor homes may be used as temporary living space for the purposes of:
 - The quarantining of a family member suspected of or diagnosed with COVID-19; or
 - The providing of care for family members relocated due to COVID-19; or
 - The need for additional residential space to accommodate children being home due to college/school closures; or
 - The inability to relocate the RV/trailer to a storage facility.
 - b) The parking regulations contained in the following sections are suspended during the duration of this order: Section 5.1.3, Section 5.1.3.1, Section 5.1.3.2, Section 5.1.3.4, and Section 5.1.3.5.
 - c) Temporary use of RV's, travel trailers, campers, and motor homes as living space must be conducted without the creations of any type of health hazards, accident, or fire hazards. The decision regarding the creation of a health hazard, accident, or fire hazard is in the City's sole discretion, as determined by the Emergency Manager. The City may enforce the provisions of Ordinance 13-122018 as necessary to ensure no collateral health hazard, accident, or fire hazard occurs.
 - d) The provisions in section 5.1.3.7, regarding Neighborhood or Homeowner's Association are not suspended. However, individual associations at their discretion may implement the provisions of this declaration regarding RV's, travel trailers, campers, and motor homes as living space.
2. That except as amended herein, the Rules and Regulations established in Ordinance No. 227-032020, adopted on March 24, 2020, remain in full force and effect.
